Setting the Table for Dine By Design East 2014

(Halifax, N.S.) Excitement is building as organizers launch the second edition of Dine By Design East—the premier design and lifestyle event in Atlantic Canada happening this fall from October 30 to November 2.

Presented by *East Coast Living* magazine, the event sees 10 Nova Scotia designers and 10 local chefs teaming up for an innovative showcase of interior design and local cuisine. Funds raised support design education at NSCAD University through the Amber Harkins Memorial Scholarship Fund. Harkins was a long-time editor of *East Coast Living* who passed away from cancer in 2012.

At the Gala evening on October 30, guests will socialize with the designers, chefs, gallerists and trendsetters, enjoying two levels of inspired design and cuisine inside a transformed Olympic Gardens venue. This year's expanded events include a lunchtime fashion show on October 31, featuring new styles by Turbine, J&R Grimsno, Mills Brothers and student work from NSCAD's Fashion and Textile Department. The design spaces will be open for public viewing November 1 and 2 with weekend workshops, including a "Modern Art Dining" seminar with chef Luis Clavel and Attica Furnishings on November 1, and a special presentation with designer and television personality Meredith Heron on November 2.
